
CMA CGM offers additional capacity to French shippers with HAROPA PORT



The 7,000 TEU APL Oregon will call at Le Havre on Thursday August 15th.

Le Havre is the privileged port of call for the seasonal French Peak Service operated by CMA CGM; this service, dedicated to the French market, serves the ports of Yantian in China, Vung Tau in Vietnam and Singapore, before arriving in Le Havre at the Terminal de France. The 1st container ship, the APL OREGON, is due to arrive on August 15. The CMA CGM Chopin will be in Le Havre on September 7 for the second call of the French Peak Service.

▶ This exceptional service launched by CMA CGM is designed to increase capacity on the Asia-Europe trade, which is currently very busy. It strengthens the service to France to better meet the expectations of French importers and exporters.
