The TOWT shipping line inaugurated its first call at the port of Le Havre with its cargo sailboat "ANEMOS" on Tuesday August 6.



At the end of the inaugural stopover in the port of Le Havre, on Tuesday August 6, the cargo sailing ship "Anemos" will carry out its first loading, bound for New York, which will launch its transatlantic crossing. During this historic crossing, more than 1,000 tons of cargo will be loaded onto this tall ship dedicated to the maritime transport of goods.

The Anemos ship features

- Nearly 900 pallet loads (1.2 tons)
- ▶ The first cargo ship with main velic propulsion
- ▶ Up to -99% CO² emissions
- Dimensions: 80m long, 15m wide and 63m draft

The company has transported more than 2 million products, and is now aiming to go to industrial scale by building a first generation of innovative, high-tech cargo sailboats.
